

LESSON 10
NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM
Alleluia! He Is Risen!

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 28:1-8; Mark 16:1-8; Luke 24:1-8; John 20:19-25. Story the children learned in Sunday School this week.

MEMORY VERSE:

- “Ah, Sovereign Lord, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too difficult for you!” Jeremiah 32:17 (NIV)

- “And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:20b (NLT)

KEY THEMES:

- The Bible contains many examples of God showing His people that nothing is too hard/difficult for Him. **This week we are learning about the most amazing example of nothing being too difficult for our God!**
- Our God is stronger than death. He can do anything.
- We are rescued from sin and its power over us when we accept what Jesus did for us on the Cross. He suffered and died for us so that we can be with God forever. His victory is ours when we accept this precious gift.
- After the resurrection of our Lord, the Holy Spirit was given to all those who believe in Jesus. When we accept what Jesus has done for us on the Cross, God/His Spirit lives in us. We have God with us all the time!
- Our Lord continues to show us how important having a relationship with Him is to Him. He went to the disciples before ascending to heaven. He knew what they needed to really know and believe in God’s power and promise to them. He assured them He would always be with them.
- Jesus glorified and honored His Father in heaven through His death and in His resurrection. God was glorified and seen by ALL through the resurrection of Jesus. Our God is mighty, victorious, and like no other!

FAMILY TIME

Encourage your child/children to celebrate this week how amazing their God is! Truly, nothing is too hard for Him to do. He is mightier than death and anything that might scare, worry, or tempt them. He is mighty to provide all that they need. He loves them so much He will do things for them that they would not imagine or even ask for! He is good. Ask them to look for how their Lord shows them this week more about who He is and wants to be to them.

WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK

Talk throughout your day to your child about who your Lord is to you and what He is doing for you or helping you with. When you notice the Lord caring for your child or doing something for them this week that is very meaningful, say to them “Wow, do you see what God did for you?” If they do not see on their own, this is OK. Share with her/him what you have seen and what the Lord has revealed to you that He has done for your child.

It is important to communicate to your children your desire to pray with them if they feel unable to hear from God on their own. Share words from the Lord with your children. You will be amazed at how special they will feel, they will receive this from the Lord through you!
