Lesson 11- The Lord Brings Victory to His People Through Deborah
NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM

SCRIPTURE: Judges 4 & Judges 5:20-21. Story the children learned in Sunday School this week.

MEMORY VERSE:

“The Lord hears His people when they call to Him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles.” Psalm 34:17 (NLT)

KEY THEMES:

- Our Lord waits for us to come to Him and see our need for His help. Our Lord will answer us, His people, when we ask Him for help.
- We must turn away from evil. The more we choose evil things, the harder it becomes to trust God and choose Him. When we choose sin, we do not receive God’s best for us. (Pay attention to how Barak did not receive all the Lord desired to give him because of his “partial” obedience and lack of trust in the Lord.)
- There is no sin too great that our Lord does not forgive. When we see our need for Him and turn to Him, He will hear our cries and help us.
- God loves us and wants to be chosen! He has great blessing and honor for His people when we listen and obey.
- Our Lord is faithful to His promises and can be trusted. God remains committed to Israel and His promises to them.

FAMILY TIME

Encourage your child/ children to spend time with God this week, getting to know Him. Ask them what they can do to know God. (pray, dialogue, read His Word that He has given them)

Older children: In addition to the above, encourage your child/ children throughout their week to turn away from evil and obey God with all of their hearts. Encourage them to turn to God in the times they are tempted or doubtful. He wants to help them and give them strength, courage, and victory. God desires to bless them and give them good things. To fully receive this, it is important to call out to Him and do what He asks them to do. He wants them to look to Him for help and guidance. He is faithful to His children. He loves them/us so much.

WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK

Share with your child/ children this week something that you have asked the Lord for help with. Celebrate the help He has given you with them. Tell your child when you are choosing to do what God is asking you to do even when it is hard. Pray with your child during a difficult situation. Stop and ask God for His help and perspective instead of reacting or correcting. After praying, ask your child what they think God is asking them to do in this situation that they are faced with. When they chose Him, give thanks to their Lord with them for what He has done! Recognize and praise your child when they chose to obey this week. Communicate with them the Lord’s pleasure when they chose Him and obey Him. Delight in them!

It is important to communicate to your children your desire to pray with them if they feel unable to hear from God on their own. Share words from the Lord with your children. You will be amazed at how special they will feel, they will receive this from the Lord through you!
