Lesson 14 – David & Goliath
NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM

SCRIPTURE: 1 Samuel 17:1–58 – Story your child learned in Sunday school this week.

MEMORY VERSE /KEY VERSES

“And everyone assembled here will know that the Lord rescues His people, but not with sword and spear. This is the Lord’s battle, and He will give you to us!” 1 Samuel 17:47 (NLT)

“The Lord is my strength and my song; he has given me victory. Songs of joy and victory are sung in the camp of the godly. The strong right arm of the Lord has done glorious things!” Psalm 118:14-15 (NLT)

KEY THEMES:

- David believes that nothing is too difficult for His Lord. David understands that the battle belongs to the Lord and He will conquer His enemies.
- Our Lord gives victory to His people in a very unlikely and hard to believe ways. There is no doubt once again that this is the Lords power not mans.
- The Lord rescues His people from danger and situations that seem impossible to be victorious in.
- God’s plan for David’s life continues. He uses this battle to establish confidence among the people in David as their leader.
- God uses circumstances in our lives to bring about His purpose. We are often unaware of this when it is happening. God knows all things, His ways are perfect and so much bigger than we can imagine.
- God continues to keep His promise to His people, the children of Israel. He keeps His promises throughout the ages. He is Sovereign and good!

FAMILY TIME

Tell your child God wants show them this week that He can be trusted with GIANT problems. Ask them for examples of what giant problems would look like in their lives. When a problem comes how exciting it will be to have the opportunity to trust God with it! Parents share a situation with your child when have done this and what the Lord did for you.

WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK

Communicate with your child openly if you/they face a situation this week that seems overwhelming or insurmountable. Pray out loud with our child in this situation. Ask God to help you/them and to take care of it for you/them. Thank God that you can trust Him to help you even if you do not understand His ways. Ask your child later if they saw what God did to help you/them. If they did not it is important that you share with them what the Lord did or what He showed you about the situation. Thank the Lord with your child and praise Him for His help and His ways!

It is important to communicate to your children your desire to pray with them if they feel unable to hear from God on their own. Share words from the Lord with your children. You will be amazed at how special they will feel. They will receive this from the Lord through you!
