Lesson 15 – The Lord Protects David From Saul
NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM

SCRIPTURE: 1 Samuel 23:19-21 – This is the story your child learned in Sunday school this week. Read 1 Samuel 18-23 for background information. Note how Saul was committed to capturing and killing David. The Lord continually protects David. This particular account (1 Samuel 23:19-21) is especially interesting because of the Lord’s timing and the creativity needed for such a last minute rescue.

MEMORY VERSE /KEY VERSES

“Ah, Sovereign Lord, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too difficult for you!” Jeremiah 32:17 (NIV)

“The Lord hears His people when they call to Him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles.” Psalm 34:17(NLT)

“The righteous person faces many troubles, but the Lord comes to the rescue each time.” Psalm 34:19(NLT)

KEY THEMES

- David believes that nothing is too difficult for His Lord. David has seen what His Lord can and will do for him. He continues to obey the Lord and trust in His provision and protection.
- David knows His God. He longs for Him and turns to Him in his time of deepest need.
- As David is running for his life the Lord continues to protect Him from his enemies.
- Our Lord is creative and His ways are incredible. Take note of how the Lord rescued David from Saul. It appeared that David was trapped. God’s timing and ways are perfect.
- David was chosen by God for great things. God chooses each one of us to participate in His kingdom. God wants to use each one of us to show people who He is and to help Him accomplish all that He desires. Do we trust Him and will we follow Him and do all that He asks of us?
- God is so good to David. He provided David with a good friend who was also instrumental in David’s protection. The Lord always provides for our needs, emotional needs as well as physical. He cares about our hearts!

FAMILY TIME

WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK

Encourage your children to spend time thinking about God and talking to Him throughout their day. Look for opportunities to talk with you children about how the Lord protects you/them and rescues you/them this week. Celebrate this truth as a family this week. With your children ask the Lord for His protection and care.

It is important to communicate to your children your desire to pray with them if they feel unable to hear from God on their own. Share words from the Lord with your children. You will be amazed at how special they will feel. They will receive this from the Lord through you!
