**LESSON 7 - Our God Provides For All Of Our Needs**  
**NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM**

**SCRIPTURE:** Exodus 16:1-35 - (Story taught in Sunday School this week)

**MEMORY VERSE**

“...for your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask Him. Pray like this:  
Our Father in heaven,  
May your name be kept holy.  
May your kingdom come soon.  
May your will be done on earth,  
as it is in heaven.  
**Give us today the food we need,**  
And forgive us our sins,  
As we have forgiven those who sin against us.  
And don't let us yield to temptation,  
But rescue us from the evil one. **Matthew 6:8b-13**

**KEY THEMES**

- God wants us to come to Him each day for our “daily bread,” knowing He will provide. He gives us what we need for each day.
- God desires that we take our needs to Him. Do we complain like the Israelites and blame others when we are afraid our needs will not be met?
- Can God be trusted to give us all we need?
- Our God will not abandon us in our times of deepest need and fear. He did not abandon the children of Israel, His children. He will NOT abandon us.

**FAMILY TIME**

*Ask your children to look for how their God is providing for their needs this week. Encourage them to talk to God about their needs and ask Him for what they need for each day. Ask them to look for times this week when God does something for them that meets their needs in a way they did not expect and were not looking for. Our God is so good to us!*

**WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK**

*Look for times that the Lord provides for you and your family each day. Talk to your child about this throughout your day. It would be good to say something like “Isn't God so good to us? He provided \_\_\_\_\_ for us today!” Share with your children how God has provided for your needs this week and throughout your life. Ask God to share with you something that He has provided for your family or your child. Share with your child what God has told you.*

*It is important to communicate to your children your desire to pray with them if they feel unable to hear from God on their own. Share words from the Lord with your children. You will be amazed at how special they will feel, they will receive this from the Lord through you!*
