LESSON 8 - The Walls of Jericho Fall Down NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM

SCRIPTURE: Joshua 6:1-27; Psalm 98:1 - Story the children learned in Sunday School this week.

MEMORY VERSE:

“He holds victory in store for the upright; He is a shield to those whose walk is blameless, for He guards the course of the just and protects the way of His faithful ones.” **Proverbs: 2:7-8**

KEY THEMES:

- God kept His promises to Moses, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. God’s fulfillment of His promises will continue until eternity. He is so big!
- Joshua was the one God had chosen to lead His people into the land He promised them. Joshua obeyed and did what the Lord asked him to do.
- Whether or not an individual, or a whole generation, benefits from God’s faithfulness depends on obedience.
- Will we trust God to be who He says He is, to keep His promises, and give us victory? Will we trust and obey Him?
- God asks that we listen to His voice and do what He asks us to do so we can receive the victory He has for us.

FAMILY TIME

Ask your children to look for how their God is giving them victories, small or big, this week. Encourage them to talk with God when they feel that they need His help. Remind them that it is God’s strength that gives us victory like He gave Joshua and the children of Israel!

WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK

Speak to your children throughout your day when you see the Lord giving you or them victory over something that is/seems very difficult or hard. Be open with your family about what is difficult for you and what you are asking God to give you victory over this week. Do not forget to celebrate this with them. It would be good to have a special dance, clap, or word when anyone in your family has victory. God is good to us!

*It is important to communicate to your children your desire to pray with them if they feel unable to hear from God on their own. Share words from the Lord with your children. You will be amazed at how special they will feel, they will receive this from the Lord through you!
Communicate with your child the Lord’s pleasure over them when they seek Him.*
