Lesson 9- What A Mighty Savior You Are!
NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 27:50-53, Mark 15:37&38, Luke 23:45B-46, John 19:30

(Story the children learned in Sunday School this week) *The curtain in the temple separated the holy place from the most holy of holies. The fact that it was torn from top to bottom testified that God is the One who ripped this thick curtain. The curtain was not torn from the bottom by men ripping it. God is showing that everyone can now come into His presence, not simply the High Priest.*

MEMORY VERSE:

“And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:20B

KEY THEMES:

- Once again our God shows us by the tearing of the curtain that He can do all things!
- What love, that our Father would will His son to die so that we can have full access to Him!
- Jesus “released” Himself to death. Jesus our Savior gave all of Himself for us.
- Jesus is the way to God Himself. We now have access to God’s presence.
- God shows Himself to us at the death of His son. His power and sovereignty.
- The power of sin and death is broken forever to those who receive what Jesus has done for us.

FAMILY TIME

As we lead up to Resurrection Sunday read with your children the passages above.

Celebrate our Lord’s great might, power, and love for us. There truly is no one like Him. This is the most amazing account we have of nothing being impossible for the Lord. Talk with your children about the significance of the curtain being torn and how it was torn. God was communicating to us that He did something that only He can do. He loves us SO much that He wants us to be able to talk with Him and know Him. What happened to Jesus on the cross is what makes it possible for us to talk with God and know Him.

WALKING ALONG THE WAY WITH YOUR CHILDREN THIS WEEK

Communicate with your child that God loves them so much He made a way to talk with them. Ask them to listen for His voice and look for how the Lord wants to show them this week how much He loves them. Tell your child how the Lord shows His love to you this week and share what He speaks to you. This would be a great week to ask the Lord about your child's gift, the one given to them at church from the 99 cent store. Observe things about their gift with them that you notice. Encourage your child to ask God about the gift He has given them. Write what they tell you they hear the Lord is saying to them. If they are unable to do this or do not seem to want to do this, it is OK. Tell them that you would like to pray with them and share what the Lord shows you for them. If you have not already shared what the prophetic team has heard from the Lord on your child's gift, this would be a good time. Our Lord wants your child to know that He will speak to them and this can come in different ways through many people. He is so good to us!
